Frame Agreement No 1-06 10.07 2015

Between: The Mediterranean Institute of Fundamental Physics, Marino, Rome Italy
(hereinafter - MIFP), represented by Giuseppe Eramo, President, and Alexei Kavokin,
Scientific Director

and: The Multidisciplinary Center "Institute for Problems of Engineering Physics of the
Georgian Technical University, Tbilisi, Georgia (hereinafter - IPEP, represented by Archil
Chirakadze, Director, Paata Kervalishvili, Scientific Consultant), hereinafter referred to as
the Parties of the Agreement.

1. Subject of the agreement:

1.1. The Parties agree on cooperation, mutual assistance and joint activities to promote and implement in countries, associated with the EU, the modern hi-tech energy-efficient technologies that contribute to the rapid achievement of:

- the sustainable development in economic, social and environmental components;
- the necessary basis for the development of a safe and a knowledge-based society;
- developed industrial production and widespread implementation of the most advanced cost-effective technologies of the "green energy" (in terms of 20-20-20 targets);
- training and retraining of highly qualified young scientific and technical personnel in the above areas.

2. The main activities of the Parties under this Agreement:

- conducting basic research in physics, chemistry, materials science and energy;
- conducting applied and engineering research in physics, chemistry, materials science and energy;
- development, commercialization and industrial application of advanced technologies and devices related to the above areas;
- exchange of young researchers, doctoral students, undergraduates and graduate students, their target training and retraining.

3. Obligations of the Parties:

1.1. The Parties undertake (in accordance with special agreements), to transfer to each other the advanced technologies and all the necessary documentation (which are subjects to copyrights of each party) for the industrial implementation within their respective areas (MIFP - European Union, IPEP - South Caucasus Countries: Georgia, Armenia and Azerbaijan). In each case, a separate agreement regulates relations between the Parties.

1.2. The Parties make every reasonable effort and use appropriate means to free mutual

assistance in the field of scientific research, engineering designs and equipment, training and retraining of specialists and commercialization of these technologies and devices in their respective areas.

4. The term of the Framework Agreement:

4.1, The Agreement enters into force upon signature of Parties and is valid for 10 years from the date of signing.
