

AGREEMENT

ON SCIENTIFIC AND ACADEMIC COOPERATION

Between
Mediterranean Institute of Fundamental Physics, Rome, Italy
And
Quantum College, Yerevan, Armenia

Mediterranean Institute of Fundamental Physics on the one hand and Quantum College on the other hand (hereafter Parties) agree upon the following provisions of cooperation in order to enhance the efforts in research projects and curricula development, to implement the exchange of research and academic staff, students' mobility, with a view to promoting learning and culture and fostering close friendship between the two Universities on the basis of principles of mutual benefit and equality.

Article 1

The Parties agree to seek mutually beneficial ways to share professional experiences and exchange information on research and teaching methodology, curricula, the training of specialists, and to explore and implement other forms of professional interaction and exchange.

Article 2

The Parties agree to encourage the exchange of scholarly and educational publications and materials, and biographical, reference and other pertinent literature. The exchange of periodicals and other publications will be carried out by the libraries of the two parties based on mutual needs and interests.

Article 3

Each Party agrees to invite representatives of the other party to participate in major congresses, conferences and symposia of mutual interest.

Article 4

The Parties agree to encourage and facilitate the exchange of students, researchers and faculty members for purposes of studying, teaching or conducting research, jointly or individually in applied sciences and engineering. The exchange details as, for example, the number of persons

to be exchanged, duration of stay, selection of candidates, etc., will be specified additionally depending on the case.

Article 5

The financial terms of exchange will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds. Hosting Party will allocate freely all necessary facilities during the visit.

Article 6

Both Parties agree, in order to raise funds, to investigate the possibilities of submitting proposals in common to international bodies such as United Nations, European Community Programs, EU's Framework Programme, ISTC, TASIC and other International programs.

Article 7

Two Parties agree to review this Agreement and its implementation on periodical basis either by exchanging delegations or by other convenient means.

Article 8

This Agreement does not exclude the possibility of organizing other forms of exchange or expanding this agreement should both Parties so desire.

Article 9

This Agreement between the Mediterranean Institute of Fundamental Physics and the Quantum College has been drawn up into two equal copies and signed in English.

Article 10

This Agreement shall enter into force upon signing and shall remain in force for five years. It will be automatically renewed for a further term of five years if neither Party expresses its intention in writing to cancel it within six months prior to its expiration.

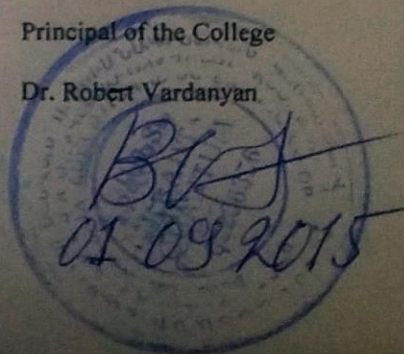
